Illinois	Missouri
<p>Certification: IDHHC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This automatically renews when you renew your license in December. If you do not have a license, this will need to be renewed every March. A maintenance form will be sent out 30 days before the expiration date which is March 1st. 	<p>Certification: MCDHH</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Expiration date is December 31st. MCDHH will send a form in the mail around October to renew. You must print out your certificates of CEUs to prove you have met the CEU requirement for that cycle. <i>If you have an RID Membership, you can print off your transcript to show proof.</i> Renewal forms must be postmarked by <u>December 2nd</u>.
<p>Licensure: IDHHC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will receive notice via email on November 1st it is time to renew. IDHHC strongly encourages your renewal to be submitted by <u>December 12th</u> to ensure it is processed before December 31st. If it is not processed before December 31st, your license will be considered expired. Renewal (username is NOT an email) Check your status here. 	<p>Licensure: SCI</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Expiration date is January 31st. You will receive an email (from interpreters@pr.mo.gov) and/or a form in the mail on <u>December 1st</u> to go in and renew online or by mail. Check your status here.

CEU Requirements

- Both Illinois and Missouri require 2.0 CEUs (20 hours), .3 (3 hours) of those CEUs must be pertaining to ethics.
- Missouri CEU cycle is November 3rd and ends November 2nd.
- Illinois CEU Cycle is January 1 to December 31.
 - If one earns MORE than the required 2.0 CEUs in one year but fails to earn 2.0 CEUs in the following year, a maximum of 1.0 CEU may be carried over into the following year.
